

## Upcoming Sermons

For our service this morning, Pastor Jim will preach on John 14:8-14. Jesus will explain the closeness of his relationship with the Father, and what that means for those who follow Him. The Quest Director, Gil Klassen will also have a questions and answers time during the service.

Next Sunday, Pastor Chris will be preaching. When we think of prophets in the Bible, Elijah is one that many of us are familiar with. He was a man of power in whom God worked powerfully! We will look at the story of Elijah, and his showdown at Mount Carmel, followed by the aftermath of that encounter, and how God is constantly present with his people, even when they don't always feel that way.

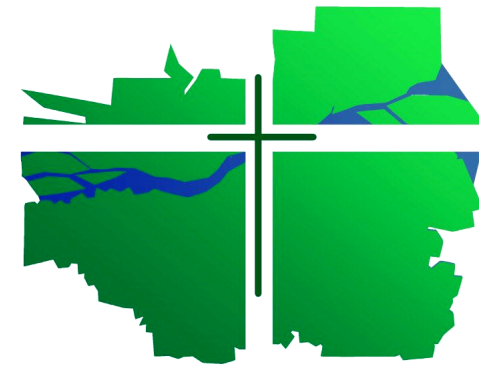

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.—Ephesians 4:1-6*
