Season of My Enemy, by Naomi Musch - "Get your farm in the fight" - the realities of WWII come to Wisconsin.

For the kids: What God Says About You

Verse to Think About:

"A curse on anyone who is lax in doing the Lord's work! A curse on anyone who keeps their sword from bloodshed! Moab has been at rest from youth, like wine left on its dregs, not poured from one jar to another—she has not gone into exile."

—Jeremiah 48:10–11

I find these verses intriguing... shocking even. Jeremiah is speaking a strong word of judgment against Moab, a people who had experienced a long season of ease and had become settled and secure. I don't take this as a word to point at others, but as an opportunity to let God examine my own heart. A life of uninterrupted comfort does not necessarily produce a life of blessing. Comfort can be the enemy. God sometimes uses change, hardship, and even disappointment to shape our character, deepen our faith, and remind us of His goodness. Am I willing to trust Him with the adventure?
