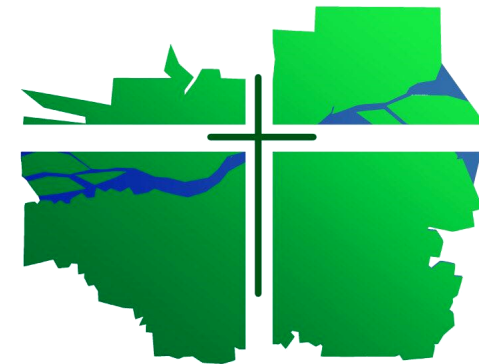

Each month we hope you learn something new about God and share it.

A Verse To Think About: *I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life. This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.—1 John 5:13-15*

In the conclusion of John's letter, he reminds his hearers of the purpose of his words: That they would believe in Jesus, that they would know they have eternal life, and that they would have confidence in approaching God. These words are a comfort to us. Depending on how we are doing, and how we've been feeling, sometimes it can feel as though God is distant, or that we have distanced ourselves from God. These words are a promise that as we come to him, and place our trust in him, we have life in him, not because of what we have done, but because of what Jesus accomplished on our behalf. We are also assured that God hears us, and listens to our words spoken to him. Not only does he listen, but he acts. Let us be reminded of God's gracious character, and the life in him he desires for all of us to live.—Pastor Chris
