Today, we start what has become a two part message about the fourth sign of Jesus in John 5; "The healing of the lame man by the pool." We will follow the episode up to the point when the healed man informs the Jewish leaders that it was Jesus who healed him. We will see Jesus ready to take the heat for an innocent man, and how that relates to how he loves us.

Next week, we will work through the rest of John 5, and see how Jesus proves to the leaders, and to us, that he is the Son of God.

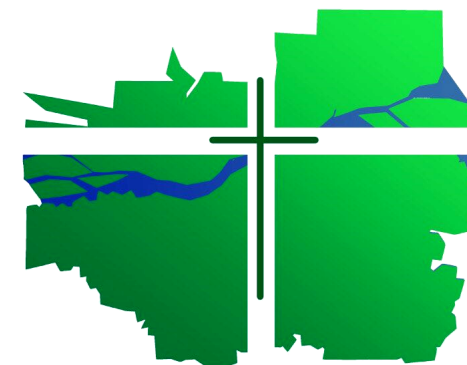
