In our passage today, we are going to look at three short teachings Jesus gives about wealth and money, and how it can either be a way to build up our own kingdoms, and seek our own security and pleasure, or how wealth can be an instrument for the kingdom of heaven. The ultimate question for us is, who are you placing your trust in? God, or money? Because it can't be both.

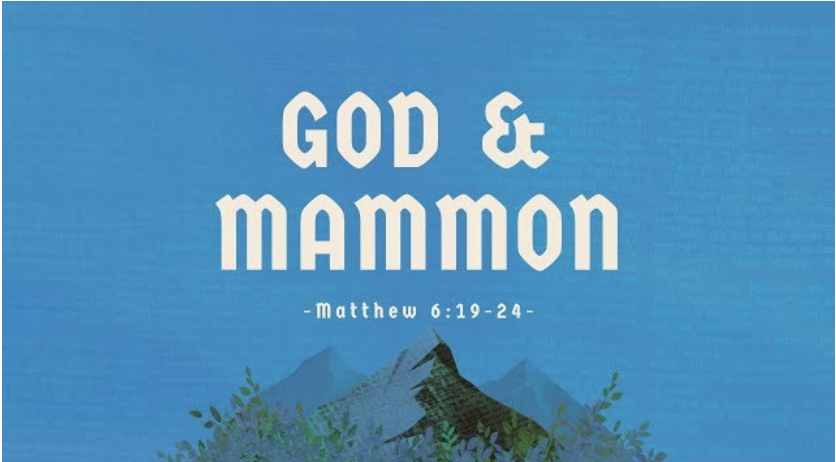
