

Upcoming Sermons

As Paul helped shepherd and guide the Corinthian church, one, among many of the issues he sought to correct, was on being the body. What does it mean to be the collective body of Christ? As the Corinthians sought to be the community of Jesus, they ended up neglecting some among them, over emphasizing specific gifts the Spirit. Paul responds by saying, the body of Christ is diverse, made up of many parts working to serve the whole. This morning, we are going to look into 1 Cor. 12, reflecting on what it means to be the body, and how we can steward the grace given to us by the Spirit so that the body can be built up.

On September 8th, we will resume our look at Joseph's life with his approach to overcoming success.

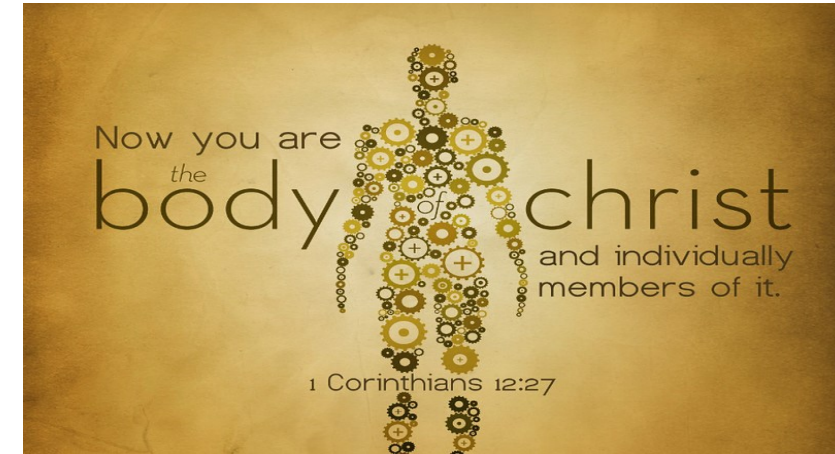
