Today we explore the topic of worry, and Jesus wisdom on the subject. Jesus has just finished speaking about the relationship between our wealth and earthly treasures, contrasted with heavenly treasure. Which one has our heart? Following this, Jesus speaks about worry because when our hearts are consumed by thoughts of our need to control our earthly treasure, worry inevitably follows. What does it look like to trust that God will provide all that we need? Do we believe that he truly cares for us? Do we think he is truly good and generous? This is Jesus' challenge for us this morning.

Next week, Pastor Chris will be looking at Matthew 7:1-6 on the topic of Judging others.







New To The Library:


