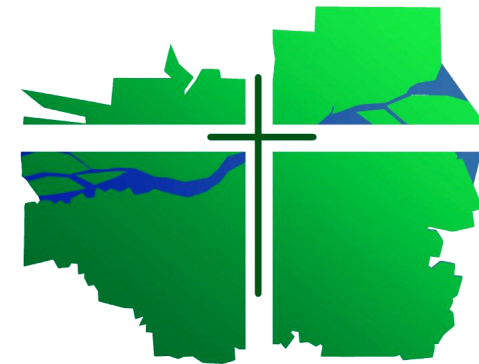

A Verse To Think About:

For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Claiming to be wise, they became fools, and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.—Romans 1:19-23

Through this verse, I am challenged to evaluate and change what I am feeding my mind, body, and spirit. Does the entertainment, the conversation, how I spend my time, the food, the activity, draw me closer to God or pull me away? I am without excuse. I am surrounded by a healthy church family and Jesus following friends and family. I have multiple Bibles, grew up in a Christian home, know the worship songs, attend small group, and help at church. Much of what I do shows a man pursuing the teachings of Jesus. Yet, in the crevices of my heart, there is sin, and I find myself being god. I become foolish, stop honouring God, and start to sliding down a slippery, dark slope. My mind shifts from the Kingdom of God to earthly things. This slip begins with the small choices, the little exceptions, the choices made in the dark. I allow the darkness to seep in. Today, where are you at?
