Am I valuable, do I matter, what is my purpose? These are all questions of Identity. We all want to know if we are valuable, and what our purpose is, but rather than looking to outside sources to discover this, we find that God in his word tells us who we are. Today we will see how Peter looks to the past to inform his understanding of the present, and how it shapes his encouragement to God's suffering people by reminding them exactly who they are in Jesus, and what God says about who his people are.

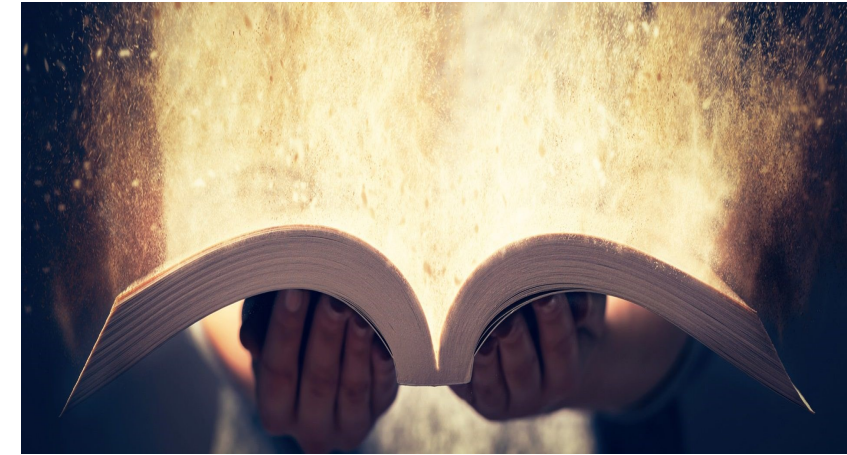

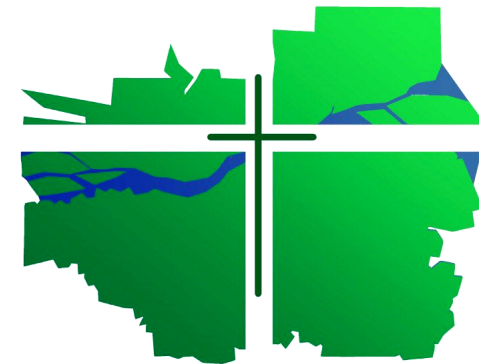
