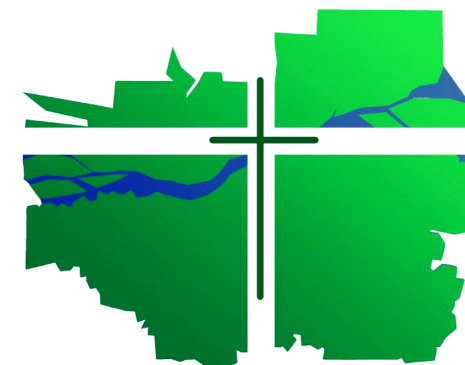

**A Verse to Think About:** Erica Bailey

"For I am afraid that when I come I may not find you as I want you to be, and you may not find me as you want me to be. I fear that there may be discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, slander, gossip, arrogance and disorder." 2 Corinthians 12:20 NIV

Gossip is a destructive power that we don't warn or preach against. Yet God warns us of the dangers of the tongue over and over. It's such a small thing, yet it can do such damage. I tried to find out how many times gossip is mentioned in the Bible. Since Gossip can be translated from many words there isn't a decisive answer. One source says 133. Another says over 500 in the Old Testament alone. Regardless the point is that we should be careful of what we say. We should take care to not spread false information. We should also take care to not spread true information that is private or not our news to share. Friends, families and churches have been split by the power of the tongue. Use it wisely.
