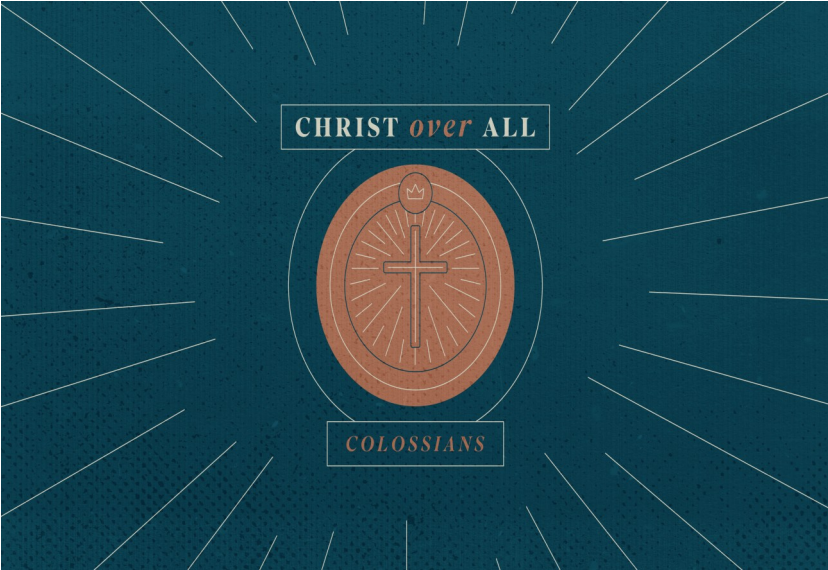

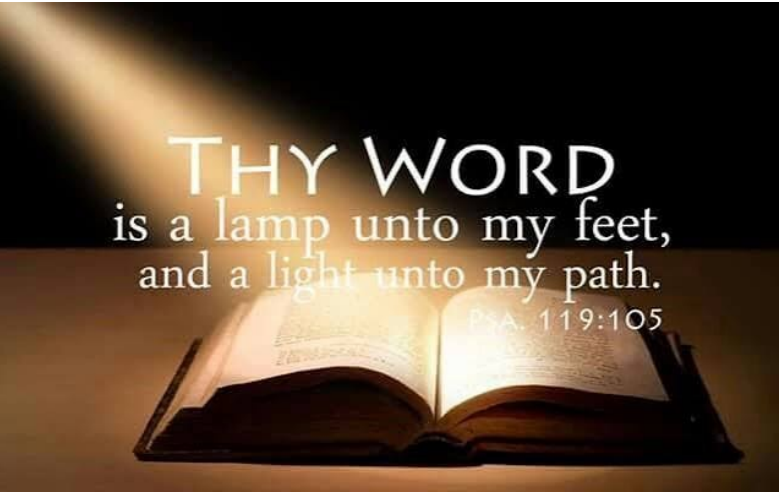
KIDS/FAMILIES
