This week, Pastor Jim will be returning to the Letter to the Colossians, as we look at the rules that the Apostle Paul lays out for Christian households in Colossians 3:18—4:1. While some of these commands may seem quaint or even oppressive today, we have to understand them in the light of the whole of Scripture, and the cultural reality of the day.

Next week, we will conclude our series in the letter to the Colossians, taking stock of Paul’s concluding words and remembering his captivity, as he tells us to “Remember my chains”. Consider all those Christians around the world today who are being persecuted for their faith. We can help them by simply remembering them in prayer.

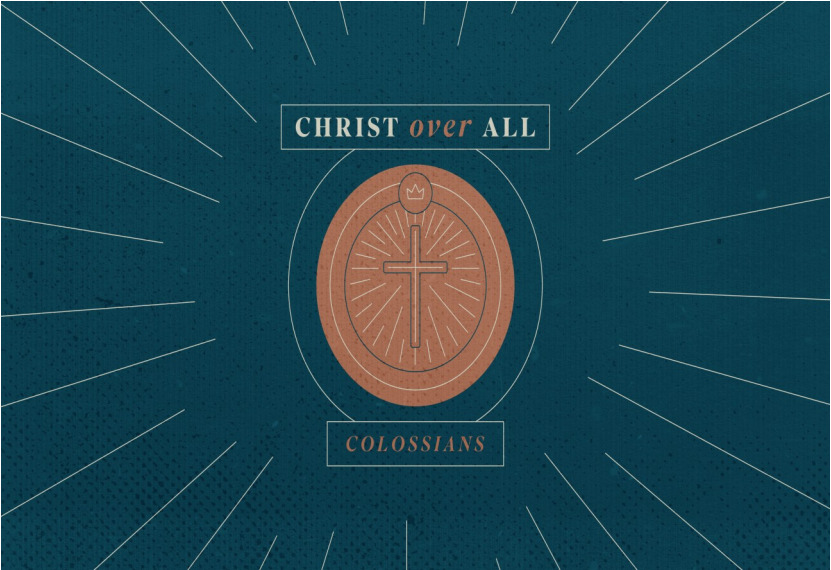
