

## Upcoming Sermons

This Sunday Pastor Chris will be preaching on 'The Table of Grace' as seen in John 6:68-69.

Today we will be reflecting on the practice of communion. Communion is something we take together on a regular basis. As important as consistent practices are, sometimes repetition can cause us to be less mindful of what exactly we are partaking in. What was communion like for Jesus' disciples, and earliest followers, and why is this practice still so valuable and important today? These are some of the questions we are going to explore this morning as we come to the table together.

Next Sunday Albert Heal will be preaching for Thanksgiving on 'Let Them Give Thanks' as seen in Psalm 107.

We are told to give thanks. It's all through Scripture. Psalm 107 lists four groups or types of specific people and says for each group: "Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men,..." The focus of my message will be on who should give thanks and for what things they/we should give thanks to the Lord.

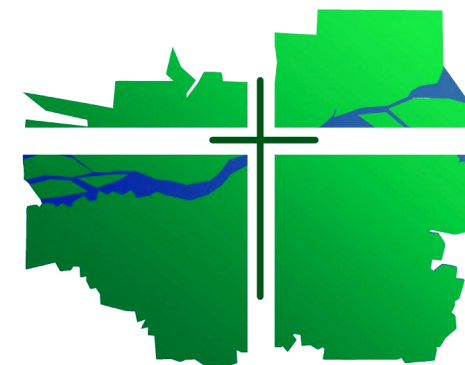
