

## Upcoming Sermons

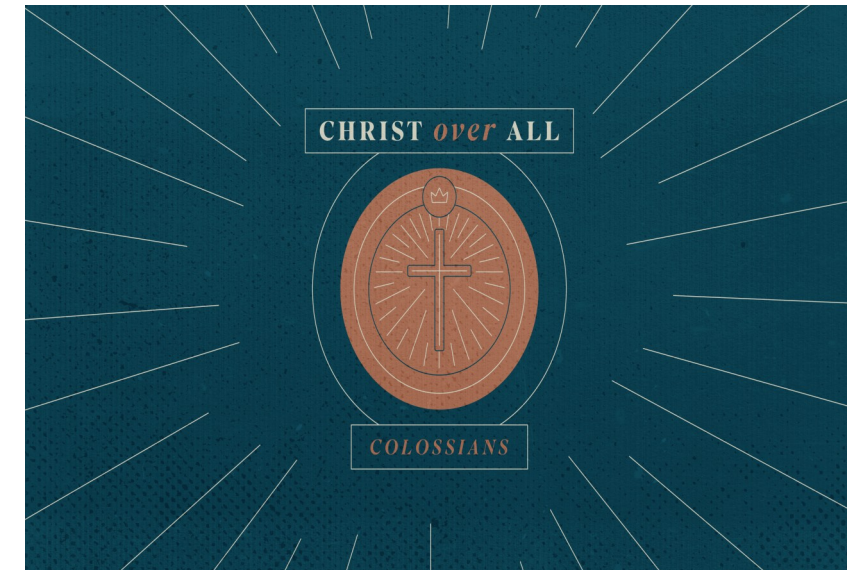
