

## Upcoming Sermons

This week, we are opening up I Thessalonians chapter 4, and learning from Paul "how to live in order to please God". Paul encourages the church to keep doing what it's doing well, which is loving God and others, but you might be surprised that the temptations faced back then were much the same as today; sexual temptations were rampant where Paul was writing from, and so he warned the Thessalonians to stay away from all impurity. He also cautioned them to live quiet and productive lives, which is much different from our current culture of "in-your-face" efforts to appeal to the general population. Paul encourages them to let their obedient to God, productive lives be their calling card in a loud and conflicted world. Next week, we will finish chapter four, and see what Paul has to teach us about the resurrection of the body, and the Second Coming of the Lord.

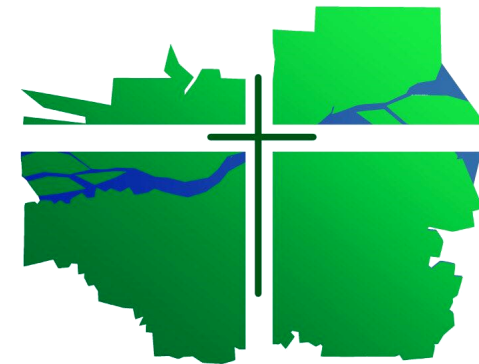

Each month we hope you learn something new about God and share it.

### A Verse to Think About:

*"If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved." Romans 10:9-10*

These two verses are one of the most concise descriptions of the Good News about Jesus that we believe as Christians. To confess Jesus as Lord in a time when Caesar was Lord was no small thing and had serious consequences. Who will I give my allegiance to? Is Jesus Lord of my life or is someone, or something else? For us to confess Jesus as Lord doesn't simply mean to say some special words, but rather to actively choose to live declaring that Jesus is ruler over my whole life, and that I have chosen to follow him. We believe this deep in our heart, and we speak about the goodness of who Jesus is to the world, and how he has changed the depths of our lives.
