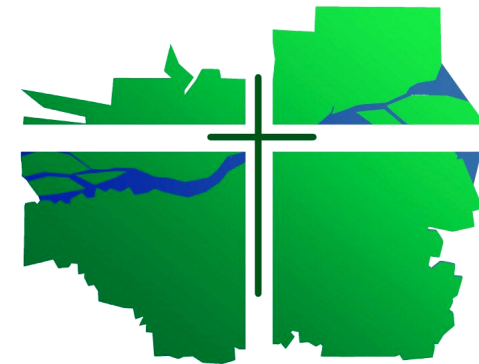

A Verse To Think About:

"Jesus told his disciples, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations beginning at Jerusalem" Luke 24:46-47

We've all heard it said, 'you can't push a rope', or 'don't put the cart ahead of the horse'. It does not steer well, and we'll soon be offtrack. So, it is with our Spiritual lives. We often overlook repentance for the forgiveness of sins. We try to do it on our own expecting results but are too often disappointed. Victory in Jesus must begin with repentance, then fix our eyes on Jesus and allow Him to work. Therefore, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
