

Upcoming Sermons

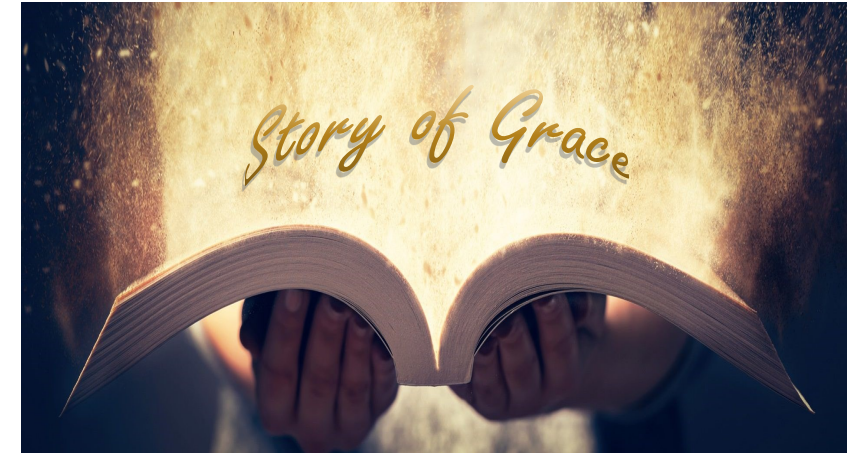

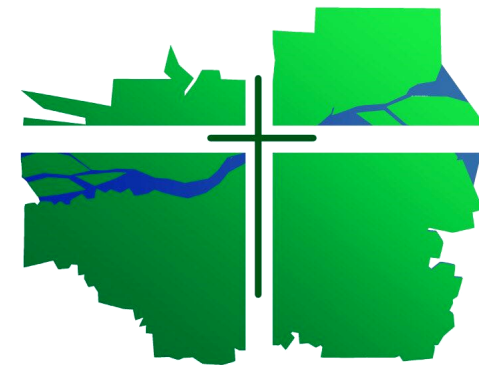

A Verse To Think About:

"My heart says of you, "Seek his face!" Your face, LORD, I will seek."—Psalm 27:8

One of our kittens is so entertaining. He tries to talk and will often look into my face. It's like he's trying to read my mind, tilting his furry face as if to say "I don't care what anybody else thinks. You are amazing!". He reminds me of this verse above. I find that intentionally seeking the Lord begins at a heart level. I don't know about you but often I feel this ache in my heart and I am learning that it is a longing for God. A longing to seek His face. I wrote a song with Claire Cloninger once that goes: "All of us are homesick for Eden, we yearn to return to a land we've never known, deep is the need to go back to the garden, a yearning so strong for a place we belong, a place that we know is home".
