

Upcoming Sermons

This week, in Colossians 3:12-17, responding to the prohibitions from the previous passage, we hear that we are to “clothe ourselves” with the virtues that come from a life lived for God. Rooted in Jesus’ love for us, let us “wear” compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience and forgiveness in such a way that people see our Jesus before they see what brand of clothing we’ve got on.

Next week, in Colossians 3:18 to 4:1, Paul lays out some instructions for the Christian household. The underlying principle in all relationships is love.

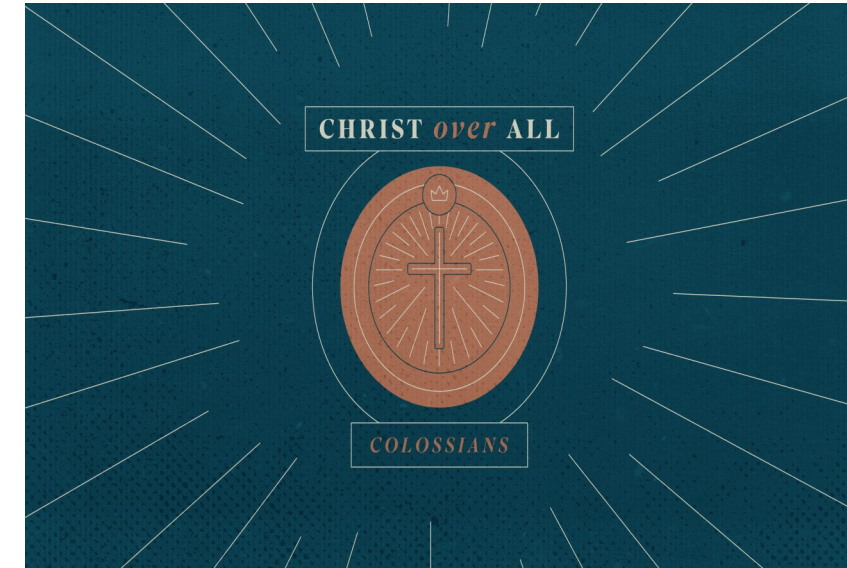

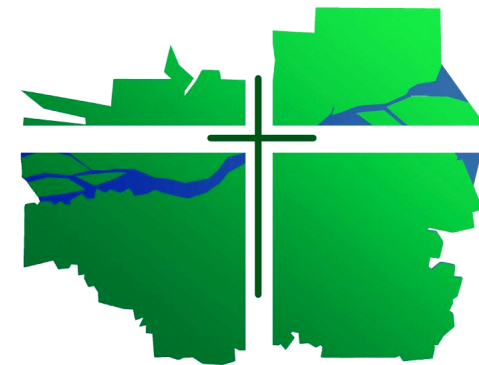
