Today, we start a sermon series rooted in the two letters to the Thessalonians. They are a small but vibrant church, serving the Lord with distinction despite enormous outside pressure. We will be learning from them as Paul speaks about serving God under pressure, the resurrection of the body, the Day of the Lord, and other important themes. As we read 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10, we will see how the Thessalonians are a church to look up to, and how they show us how we can be one, too.

You are encouraged to make a reading of the two letters a weekly devotion, and jot down any questions you may have for Pastor Jim.

Next week, we will open up the second chapter of I Thessalonians, and learn about leading by example from Paul and Silas. This has lessons for all believers!

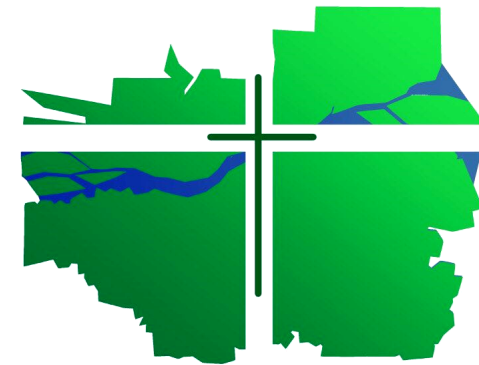
