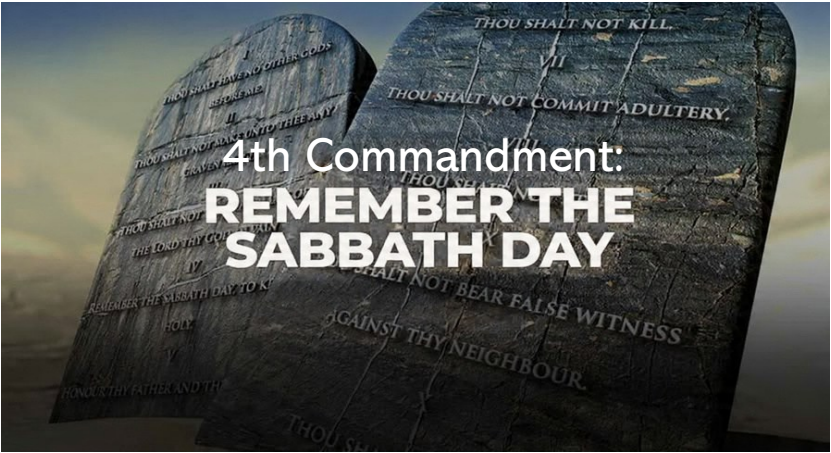

Monthly Financial Update: December 2025

	Revenue	Expenses	Balance

YTD Totals	\$318,569.56	\$295,063.55	\$23,506.01

The December Benevolent Offering was \$1,022. Along with funds already in the Benevolent account we were able to give out 31 Christmas gift cards for a total of \$1,550.

The special Christmas offering for the Quest was \$3,640. In addition, several cheques were made out directly to the Quest and are in addition to this amount. Those cheques were given to the Quest and will be receipted by the Quest instead of FBC. Counting those donations, the total offering was approximately \$5,000.

Verse to Think About:

“I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.”
—Galatians 2:20

Here Paul is saying that he is completely “sold out” to the one and only true God who died on a cross so that we could be reconciled with him. He has died to self, and he now lives for Christ. Not just in the next life but right now. Totally focused, giving 100%, not looking back but working towards the goal. Jesus never said, “Repeat after me”, he said “follow me”. In Matthew 16:24 Jesus said, “If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.” Jesus’ death and resurrection gives us eternal life and dying to self and following Jesus gives us life worth living through a sacrifice that we were unable to make.—Gerry Ginter
