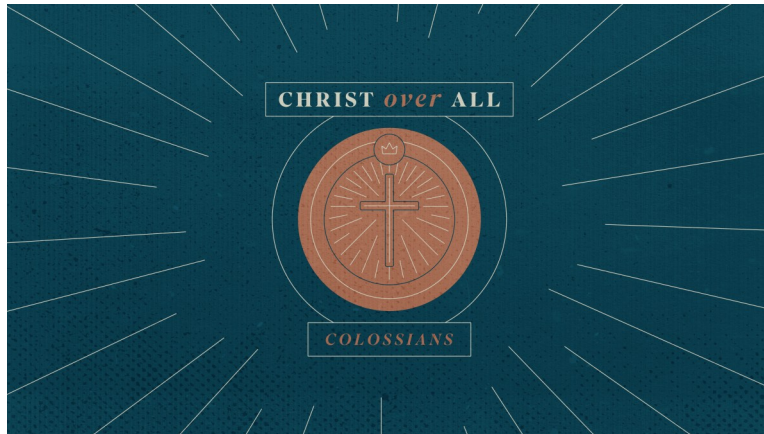


Upcoming Sermons

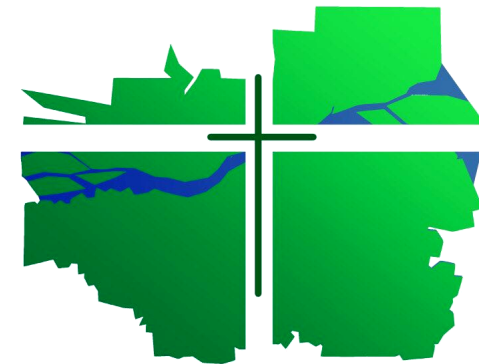
