

Upcoming Sermons

This morning, we are going to start Chapter 6 of Jesus' Sermon on the mount. Jesus begins this section addressing three important religious practices. Giving, Prayer, and Fasting. Jesus begins this whole section with a warning: Be Careful. Be careful that when you practice these things, your motivation is to honor God, not seek praise. It's easy to fall into the trap of pride, desiring people to notice all the things we do well, and to desire praise and attention for it. Yet Jesus says, be careful! We can end up doing the right things, for all the wrong reasons. When we give, it should be to honor God and give glory to Him, not to seek the honor and attention from others.

Next week, we will continue looking at Matthew with 6:5-15, working through the Lord's prayer and Jesus warning again to 'be careful'.

Sunday, September 28th we are excited to have the men from Teen Challenge lead our worship service. The Teen Challenge team will lead us in music, share testimonies, and share a short message. They will also be joining us for a potluck lunch after the service.
