This week, we finish John's prologue, seeking to understand what it means that Jesus becomes flesh, and making sure that we make the decision to believe in Him so that we can become God's child.

Next week, we will begin our series in the Signs of Jesus in John, the specific miracles of Jesus that John highlights, so that we will understand Jesus and his Mission better.

They are:

1. John 2:1-11 - Turning Water into Wine
2. John 2:12-17 - Cleansing the Temple
3. John 4:46-54 - Healing the Nobleman's Son
4. John 5:1-15 - Healing the Lame Man
5. John 6:1-15 - Feeding the Multitude
6. John 9 - Healing the Blind Man
7. John 11 - Raising Lazarus

You are encouraged to read ahead, and bring any questions you have to Pastor Jim. One of the prominent research materials he's using is Anthony Selvaggio's **The Seven Signs: Seeing the Glory of Christ in the Gospel of John**. It is out of print, but available as an eBook.

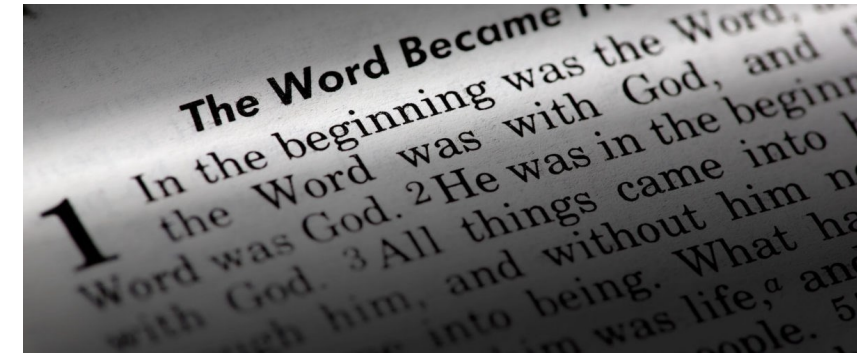

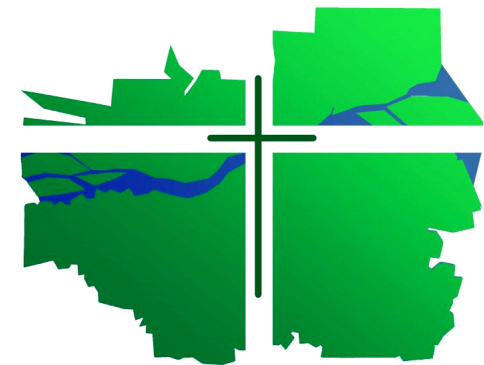
