

Upcoming Sermons

This week, Paul starts to address the problems facing the Colossian church. In this passage, he brings up namely their dependence on worldly wisdom and philosophies. They have lived for so long in a world steeped with worldly thinking. So they were struggling to let it go. Paul shows them that Jesus is enough, they need no more and no less than Jesus to thrive as Christians, regardless of what the world may say or do.

Next week, in Colossians 2:16-23, Paul will continue to address issues that the Colossians are struggling with, this time focusing on the Jewish heritage of some of the believers. Like many other newer Jewish converts to Christianity, they were struggling with letting go of all the ritual and regulations of their former life. Paul teaches us that we have freedom from the past in Jesus Christ, and that we no longer belong to this world.

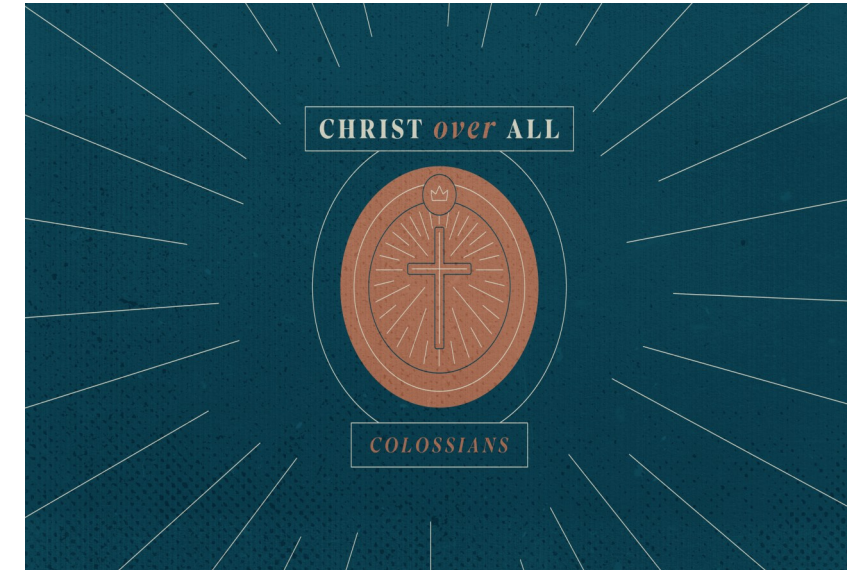

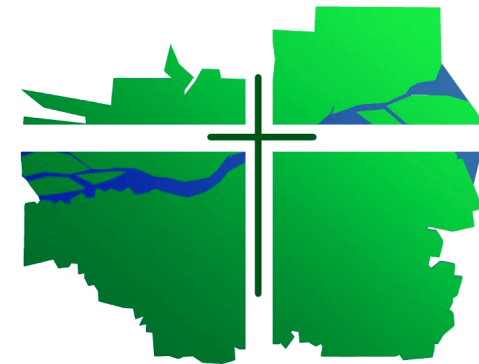
