

Upcoming Sermons

This Week, in Colossians 2:16-23, Paul continues to address issues that the Colossians are struggling with, this time focusing on the Jewish heritage of some of the believers. Like many other newer Jewish converts to Christianity, they were struggling with letting go of all the ritual and regulations of their former life. Paul teaches us that we have freedom from the past in Jesus Christ, and that we no longer belong to this world.

Next Week, in Colossians 3:1-11, we hear Paul tell us to “Set our hearts on things above”, instead of letting the world be our focus. This focus on heavenly things and God’s direction that will help us navigate what we contend with here on Earth. It is not a call to have “our head in the clouds”, but rather a exhortation to let God’s heavenly knowledge, wisdom, and power direct and guide our earthbound lives.

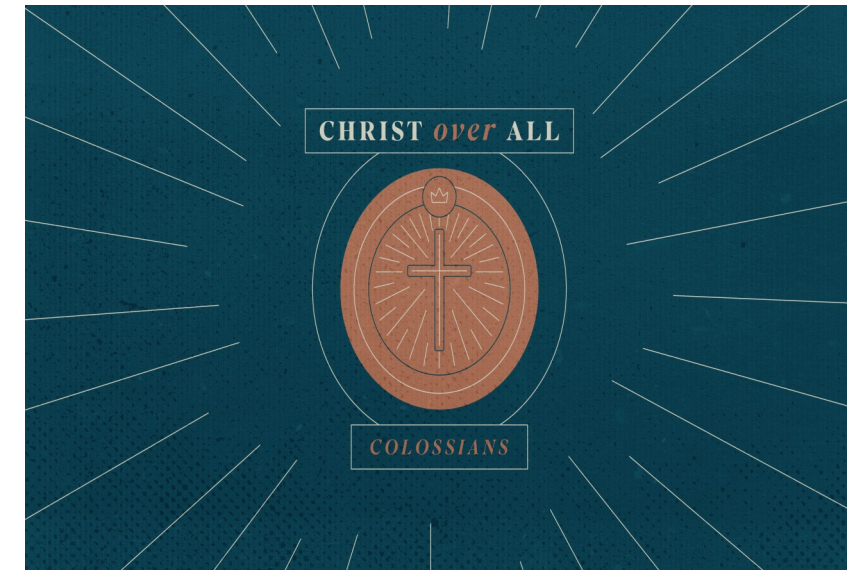

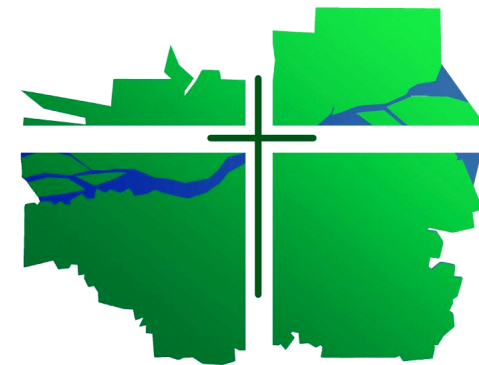
