Upcoming Sermons

This morning, we welcome Akeem Adepoju to the pulpit to share a message.

Jesus said "Remember Lot's wife" in Luke 17:32 as a stark warning about the dangers of looking back when God calls you forward. Her story, found in Genesis 19, is brief but powerful: when fleeing the destruction of Sodom, the angel of the Lord commanded Lot and his family not to look back (verse 17), but Lot's wife disobeyed and was turned into a pillar of salt (verse 26). With this, our Lord Jesus is emphasizing that OBEDIENCE to His words, in this crooked and perverse world, must be wholehearted and not negotiable. Lot's wife is the only woman Jesus explicitly tells us to remember and that makes her story worth reflecting on.

Next Sunday, Pastor Chris will be preaching on Matthew 6:25-34, "God's Character and Our Concerns".
