For the kids: What God Says About You

Verse to Think About:

1 John 1: *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will
forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.*

I learned this verse early in Bible school, probably in our first
year evangelism class in 1988. It was part of a series of verses
that we could share with someone about Jesus. Jesus is ready to
forgive us, and it's up to us to bring our sins to him and ask. That
requires us to admit that we need forgiveness, and then come to
the one who can give it to us. Nothing is too big or small to bring
to Jesus, and no one is too far away from him.—Pastor Jim
