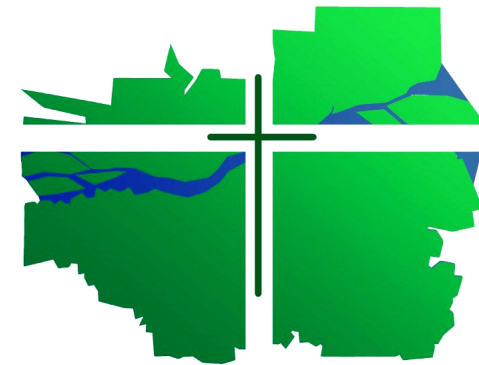

**A Verse to Think About:** Albert Heal

“Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The Lord, the Lord, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation.’ With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.” (Isaiah 12:2&3)

I was reminded this week of a song we sang often in Sunday School: “I’ve got the joy, joy, joy down in my heart. Where? Down in my heart! ... down in my heart to stay.” Joy is one of the fruits of the Spirit (Gal 5:22). Christians should be filled to overflowing with joy. Even in times of hardship we can have the joy of the Lord. The Apostle Paul is a prime example when he was in prison for the Gospel on numerous occasions and still had joy in his life. “The waters of joy from the never-ending well of salvation are ours to draw from at every moment.”
