This morning, Pastor Chris will be preaching on the theme of redemption looking at Mark 10:45 where Jesus talks about giving his life as a "ransom" for many. What does it mean that Jesus paid a ransom price for us, or that we are redeemed by the blood of the lamb? We will look at the story of the Passover, and how Jesus came to set people free.

Next week (April 12), we will be celebrating Solidarity Sunday along with other churches across Canada that support Canadian Baptist Ministries (CBM). We will have mission-based readings, hear a sermon from CBM President Jennifer Lau and see video updates from CBM missionaries all over the world.

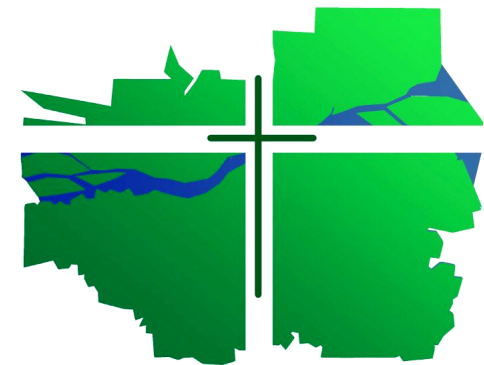
