

Upcoming Sermons

This morning, Pastor Chris will be starting a sermon series called "Our Story" looking at 1 Peter, and the story that Peter is telling believers they are a part of.

Stories are powerful things! They can teach us, entertain us, help us to imagine and wonder. Often we find ourselves identifying with characters in a story as we relate to people we hear about, whether fictional or real. People tell stories about themselves all the time, about who we are, what we do, or what we've experienced in the past. These stories we tell ourselves actually shape our understanding of who we are. The stories we tell aren't always true or helpful. Sometimes we tell ourselves lies about who we are, or hear things that aren't true about ourselves from other people. What we hear shapes how we see ourselves and how we make sense of the world we live in. What kind of Story does the bible tell us about who God is, and who we are? Do we allow *that* story, the story of Jesus and what he has done for us, to define us and provide a sense of identity and worth? This week we will be looking at "A Story of Hope" as Peter reminds his audience of the Living Hope they have.

Next Sunday, Quest Director, Gil Klassen will be preaching as well as providing an end of summer update on the camp.

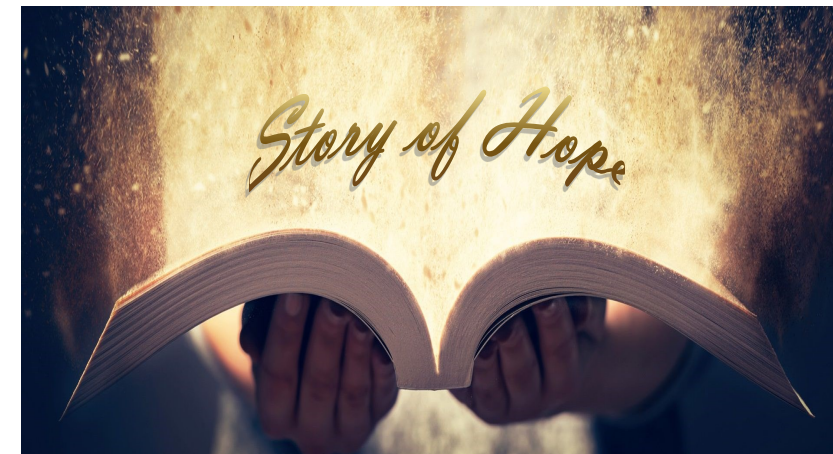

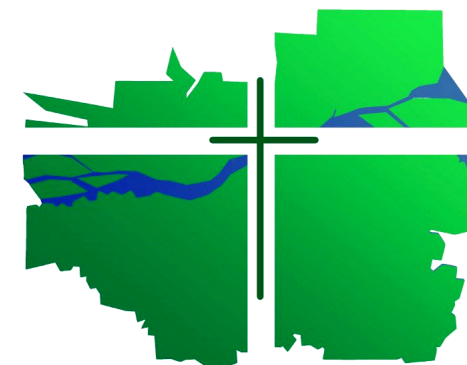

A Verse To Think About:

*"Answer me when I call to you, my righteous God. Give me relief from my distress; have mercy on me and hear my prayer."
"In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, LORD, make me dwell in safety." —Psalm 4:1 & 8*

I love how in so many Psalms, the author often begins by bringing an honest request to God, from the heart. Answer me God, please hear me, have mercy on me. Simultaneously, the Psalms often end in praise, and trust that God will act because of his righteousness and goodness. There is a mix of honest plea, an acknowledgement of frustration, or difficulty; but there is also a trust shown, and an understanding of the character of God.

Psalms model for us that God invites our honest hearts and feelings into the place of prayer, and worship, and they also show us that God can be trusted, that he will respond, and that he hears and understands the desires of our hearts.
