

Upcoming Sermons

This morning we are going to look at Matthew 5:21-26. In this passage, Jesus equates anger with a brother or sister to murder. That seems like a pretty serious comparison to make! So why does Jesus take anger so seriously? Because Jesus is concerned with your heart. In Jesus' Kingdom, being in right relationship with others is extremely important, and anger and contempt towards others leads to fractured and hurt relationships. This morning we will explore what Jesus has to say about anger, and see that he is concerned with our hearts; about who we are now, and who we are becoming.

Next week, On March 9, we will resume our journey through the Beatitudes, with the first of a two part message rooted in the seventh Beatitude, "Blessed are the Peacemakers" – Matthew 5:9 and Matthew 5:38-42

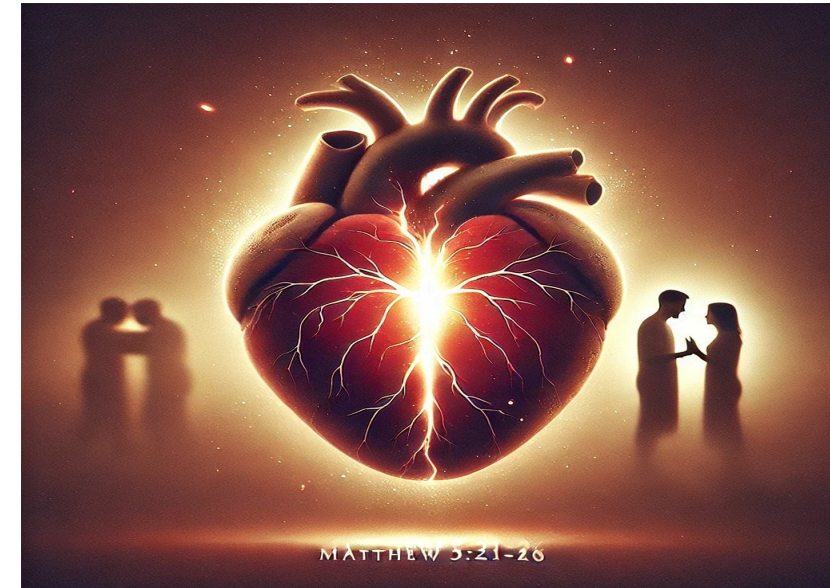

A Verse to Think About:

Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. Psalm 23:4

Psalm 23 has become very familiar to many of us over the years. It is a beautiful expression of God's presence and care for us as he guides and directs our steps. What I find most comforting is verse 4, where David acknowledges the reality of the valley. David underwent many valleys in his life. Trials, struggles, temptations, and failure.
