Just before this passage, Jesus spoke about how to respond to those who do evil towards us, and our response is to do good. But Jesus takes things further still. It's not just about withholding our retaliation, but actively loving those who we would call our enemy. How is that possible? How am I to not only withhold my vengeance, but also actively love those who wrong me? This is what we will explore this morning.
