This morning, we will be looking at the seventh commandment, **You shall not commit adultery** (Exodus 20:14), and combining that with Jesus' warning about lust in Matthew 5:27-30. Remaining faithful to our spouse, or if we are single, not interfering in someone's marriage, is essential to keeping the family strong. Jesus, as always, calls us to go deeper than the law and look at our hearts, where temptation to sin can start.

Next Week, we will review the eighth commandment, "You shall not steal" (Exodus 20:15), seeking to understand the need to respect each other's property, to be content with what we have, and to be generous to others.

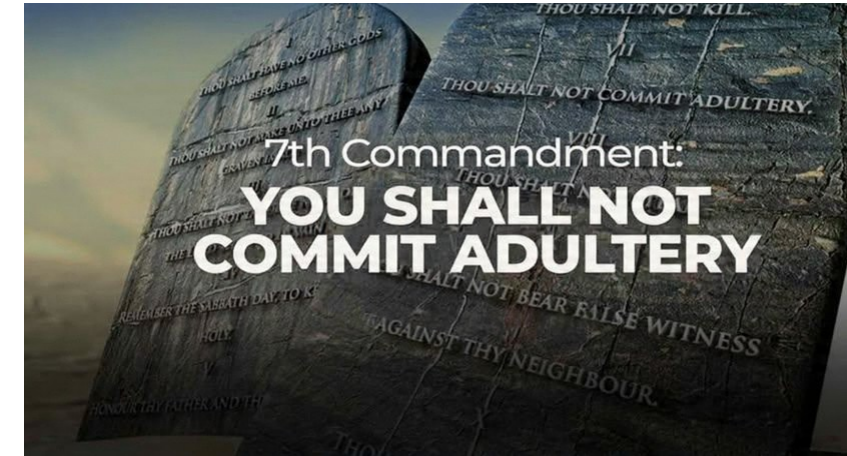

On top of the \$6,258 deficit, we had the expense of \$3,309 for stripping and waxing the floors. With our new budget we need to average \$26,347/month.

Serve Money Fundraiser: This is to help provide clarity and instructions for the Serve envelope fundraiser. This is how it works: The envelopes are numbered 1-100. They are not in order, and so whichever envelope you grab will have one of those numbers. You may get 26, or 84, who knows! The idea is that whatever number you find inside is the amount you pledge to donate towards Serve. If all the envelopes are taken, we will raise \$5050! That's amazing! But you will never be at risk of paying higher than \$100 in any given envelope, as that's the maximum, and there is only one envelope worth \$100! You are not limited to one envelope either, so be as generous as you feel. You can get a charitable receipt by putting your name on the envelope. You can pay either by cheque or cash into the envelope, and depositing it in the lockbox by the offices, or you can e-transfer that amount to donate@fbcpa.net as well. Just be sure to clarify it's for Serve! If you have a regular envelope offering number, you can use that as well. If you have any questions, please ask Pastor Chris.
