

Sean with E3: The mission trip to Switzerland was meaningful. I worked with refugees from the war in Ukraine and Hope for Orphans who are still doing camps in Europe. We saw 18 of the 50 children make first time professions of repentance and faith in Jesus. Praise God.

I also did some 3/3rds discovery Bible study training with a few folks I met who want to plant a church for Ukrainian refugees.

In recent weeks I have been sharing the Gospel and baptizing new believers in Sylvan Lake and Calgary.

Pray for safety and for favour as I am preparing to go to Thailand in the coming weeks. I will be working on a water project and some E3 church planting in villages in that area.

I will also have a gospel vision casting trip to Cambodia, leading a team to train local missionaries in Malaysia
