

Upcoming Sermons

This morning, we are going to hear a couple of the testimonies from the youth. Lyla and Mason will be sharing their stories with us, for the reason Jesus matters to them, and how he has been at work in their lives.

Pastor Chris will be following up to this with a short message on 1 Peter 3:15. Peter tells us to always be prepared to give the reason for the hope that is in you. Are you prepared to do this? As we reflect on the youth's stories, and this passage, the question for us is, what does it mean to share the reason for the hope that we have? What might be holding us back from being willing and ready to share the Good News of Jesus with others? I hope that you find encouragement this morning both to know the hope we have in Jesus, and the courage to share that hope with the world.

Next Week, Pastor Jim resumes the series on the Ten Commandments. We will be looking at the seventh commandment, **You shall not commit adultery** (Exodus 20:14), and combining that with Jesus’ warning about lust in Matthew 5:27-30. Remaining faithful to our spouse, or if we are single, not interfering in someone’s marriage, is essential to keeping the family strong. Jesus, as always, calls us to go deeper than the law and look at our hearts, where temptation to sin can start.

Serve Money Fundraiser: This is to help provide clarity and instructions for the Serve envelope fundraiser. This is how it works: The envelopes are numbered 1-100. They are not in order, and so whichever envelope you grab will have one of those numbers. You may get 26, or 84, who knows! The idea is that whatever number you find inside is the amount you pledge to donate towards Serve. If all the envelopes are taken, we will raise \$5050! That's amazing! But you will never be at risk of paying higher than \$100 in any given envelope, as that's the maximum, and there is only one envelope worth \$100! You are not limited to one envelope either, so be as generous as you feel. You can get a charitable receipt by putting your name on the envelope. You can pay either by cheque or cash into the envelope, and depositing it in the lockbox by the offices, or you can e-transfer that amount to donate@fbcpa.net as well. Just be sure to clarify it's for Serve! If you have a regular envelope offering number, you can use that as well. If you have any questions, please ask Pastor Chris.
