

Kate Mazurak shares her thoughts:

"Noah did this; he did all that God commanded him." Genesis 6:22

I often think about Noah's faith and how he responded to God. God asked him to build an ark that wasn't close to any particular body of water. God had very specific instructions for the dimensions of the ark and what it was to be made of as well as what to fill it with. Noah listened to God and obeyed.
