

Upcoming Sermons

This morning, Pastor Chris will be preaching on the Beatitudes as seen in Matthew 5:3-12.

There is no shortage of passages that address Christian character and how we are to live as followers of Jesus. As Jesus goes up on a mountain to preach to his disciples, he gives the famous sermon on the mount. He begins with what we call the "beatitudes." Jesus has been speaking of the kingdom of God, healing people miraculously, and calling his disciples to come to him. This is his first teaching recorded in Matthew, and he begins by speaking about the kind of people God calls blessed in his Kingdom, and how they are to live in the world. What kind of person does Jesus call blessed, and how are they to respond to his invitation?

Pastor Jim will resume his "Seven Signs" series on Sunday, February 26th with part 4.





“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.”

—Galatians 5:22-23
