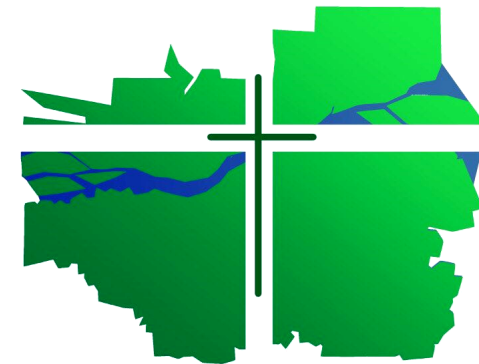

**A Verse To Think About:** *"The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life, but the mouth of the wicked conceals violence."—Proverbs 10:11*
