

## Upcoming Sermons

This morning, we look at the sixth commandment, **You shall not murder**, and how it applies to current day issues like abortion, capital punishment, Medical Assistance in Dying, and war. We will also see how Jesus expands upon this commandment, making us look at how we treat other people.

Next week, we are going to hear a couple of the testimonies from the youth. Lyla and Mason will be sharing their stories with us, for the reason Jesus matters to them, and how he has been at work in their lives.

Pastor Chris will be following up to this with a short message on 1 Peter 3:15. Peter tells us to always be prepared to give the reason for the hope that is in you. Are you prepared to do this? As we reflect on the youth's stories, and this passage, the question for us is, what does it mean to share the reason for the hope that we have? What might be holding us back from being willing and ready to share the Good News of Jesus with others? I hope that you find encouragement this morning both to know the hope we have in Jesus, and the courage to share that hope with the world.

Following the service, please feel free to join us in the gym for coffee and treats and to get to know one another.


