This morning we will be looking at Matthew 6:5-15. This passage is at the center of the Sermon on the mount, and is central to the whole of Jesus' message. Jesus instructs his followers again to be careful not to practice prayer like the hypocrites who want to be seen by others, but instead to pray to their Father in heaven. If you're like me, maybe this passage and the Lord's prayer have begun to lose their meaning and significance for you, but for Jesus, this model for prayer was central for how he himself related to his Father, and how we are to relate to our heavenly Father. As we explore the Lord's prayer today, I hope we can see it with fresh eyes, and see how we can implement it every day in our lives.

Next Sunday, we are excited to have the men from Teen Challenge lead our worship service. The Teen Challenge team will share testimonies and share a short message. They will also be joining us for a potluck lunch after the service.
