

### A Verse to Think About:

*Now all has been heard; here is the conclusion of the matter: Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the duty of all mankind.—Ecclesiastes 12:13*

This verse is King Solomon's conclusion to his searching for answers. Written before Jesus came, it is a succinct direction to honour God in our lives. Earlier this week, I posted this verse to my Facebook page, and one of the reactions I got was incredulous. My friend has no desire at all to fear God at all. I explained to her that the fear spoken of is not the kind of fear we have when we're nervous about sounds in the night or a scary movie. It is a deep rooted respect and awe of God that comes from our realization of his complete power, authority and being. I shared another verse, Proverbs 1:7 - *The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction. When in doubt or when facing trouble, start with God, search out his word, and do what you know he wants you to do.—Pastor Jim*

## YOUTH

**Serve Money Fundraiser:** This is to help provide clarity and instructions for the Serve envelope fundraiser. This is how it works: The envelopes are numbered 1-100. They are not in order, and so whichever envelope you grab will have one of those numbers. You may get 26, or 84, who knows! The idea is that whatever number you find inside is the amount you pledge to donate towards Serve. If all the envelopes are taken, we will raise \$5050! That's amazing! But you will never be at risk of paying higher than \$100 in any given envelope, as that's the maximum, and there is only one envelope worth \$100! You are not limited to one envelope either, so be as generous as you feel. You can get a charitable receipt by putting your name on the envelope. You can pay either by cheque or cash into the envelope, and depositing it in the lockbox by the offices, or you can e-transfer that amount to [donate@fbcpa.net](mailto:donate@fbcpa.net) as well. Just be sure to clarify it's for Serve! If you have a regular envelope offering number, you can use that as well. If you have any questions, please ask Pastor Chris.
