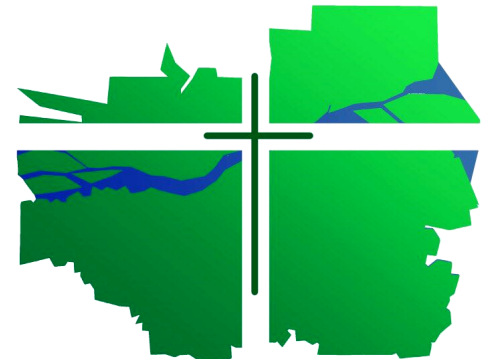

A Verse To Think About

"Adam lay with his wife again, and she gave birth to a son and named him Seth, saying, "God has granted me another child in place of Abel, since Cain killed him." Seth also had a son, and he named him Enosh." At that time men began to call on the name of the Lord." Genesis 4:25-26

Adam was 130 years old when Seth was born and Seth was 105 years old when Enosh was born. So it was over 235 years after God created Adam & Eve that people began to call on the Lord. Our forefathers had a rough start. Adam & Eve sinned and got banished from the Garden of Eden. Their firstborn, Cain, murdered his brother Abel and it seems he and his descendants turned away from God. Canada has been a nation for 157 years.
