

Upcoming Sermons

Today, we open the seventh beatitude, “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God”. In the first part of this two part message, we will learn what Jesus means when he says, “*You have heard that it was said, ‘Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.’ But I tell you, do not resist an evil person.*” and how that applies to being the peacemaker that Jesus wants us to be.

Next week, we will return to this beatitude, expanding our definition of a peacemaker by reading the words of Jesus in Matthew 5:43-48, in which he famously teaches, “*love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your Father in heaven*”.

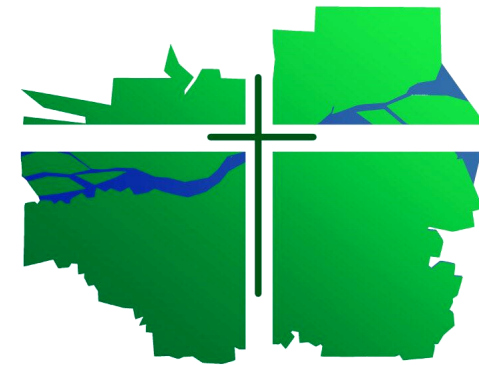
