

A Verse to Think About:

Mathew 22:37-39 Jesus replied: "‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ Again, in John 13:35 Jesus said “By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.” So how then is it that the Bible is labeled “hate speech”? Our government is trying to ram through Bill C-9 that is labeled as the “Hate Speech Law” without debate. They know that the majority of Canadians are against this bill and are not in favour of having our God given rights taken away and our freedoms restricted. They are no longer serving God but are serving Satan. While the Quran teaches to hate, the Bible tells us over and over that we are to love our neighbor.
