This morning we will look at the final of the three practices where Jesus warns us to Be Careful! Be careful that when you fast, you don't practice your righteousness to be seen by others. Giving and prayer both feel like familiar practices for many of us, but fasting? Fasting might feel a bit more optional, or like something we do *sometimes*. So what is fasting, and why was it such an important practice for the Israelites, and the early church? And if it was important for them, how should we view and practice fasting today? This is what we will explore this morning.

Next Sunday, Albert Heal will be preaching on Count Your Spiritual Blessings as seen in Ephesians 1:1-14. We have much to be thankful for this Thanksgiving season. At least eight times in Ephesians 1 we are told of spiritual blessing we receive "in Christ," "through Christ' or "in Him".
