PLEASE BE AWARE

Scam Alert: This week, many of you received a text from someone pretending to be Pastor Jim. It came from a 260 number, and it asked you for a favour. It was a scam. Apparently, a scammer got a hold of our church directory and is using it to text people and ask them to buy gift cards, which they then cash in for themselves. Once we were aware of it happening, we contacted the police and took steps to warn people. Church staff will never send you a text or email asking for monetary favours, whether they be email transfers, purchase of gift cards, or any financial transaction. There is the potential for the scammer to pretend to be someone else, a staff member or anyone in the directory, and try again. If you ever get a text from someone in the church that seems suspicious, do not reply. Check the number to see if is coming from the person, and call the church office if anything seems suspicious. A formal fraudulent report has been made to the city police, with an active case number.
