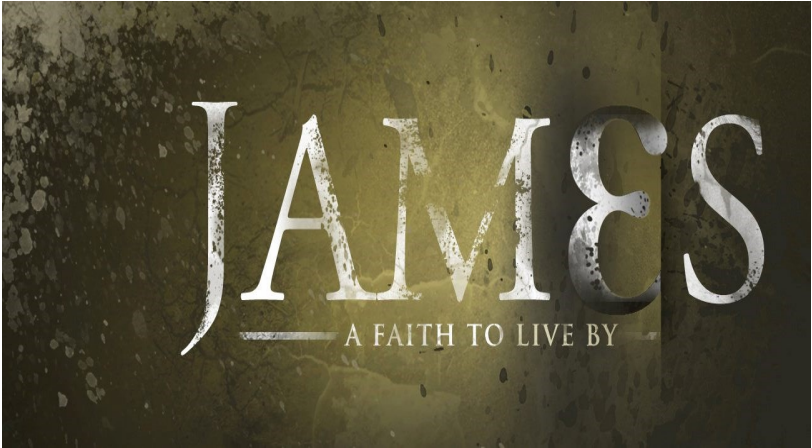

Take time to invest in relationships and invite someone to church.

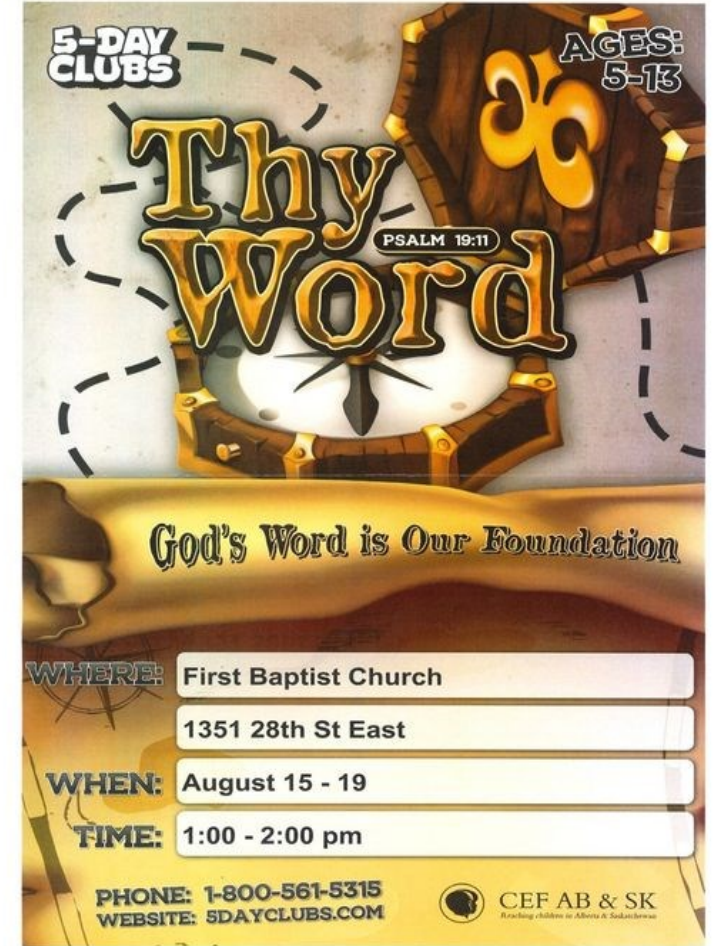
